What information we collect and use, and why

1. Staff recruitment, administration and management

We collect or use the following personal information as part of **staff recruitment, administration and management**:

- Contact details (e.g. name, address, telephone number or personal email address)
- Date of birth

- Employment history (e.g. job application, employment references or secondary employment)
- Performance records (e.g. reviews, disciplinary records, complaints or disciplinary action)

2. Network administration and management

We collect or use the following personal information as part of **network administration and management**:

- Contact details (e.g. name, address, telephone number or personal email address)

Lawful bases and data protection rights

Under UK data protection law, we must have a “lawful basis” for collecting and using your personal information. There is a list of possible [lawful bases](#) in the UK GDPR. You can find out more about lawful bases on the ICO’s website.

Which lawful basis we rely on may affect your data protection rights which are set out in brief below. You can find out more about your data protection rights and the exemptions which may apply on the ICO’s website:

- **Your right of access** – You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information. You can request other information such as details about where we get personal information from and who we share personal information with. There are some exemptions which means you may not receive all the information you ask for. [Read more about the right of access.](#)
- **Your right to rectification** – You have the right to ask us to correct or delete personal information you think is inaccurate or incomplete. [Read more about the right to rectification.](#)
- **Your right to erasure** – You have the right to ask us to delete your personal information. [Read more about the right to erasure.](#)
- **Your right to restriction of processing** – You have the right to ask us to limit how we can use your personal information. [Read more about the right to restriction of processing.](#)

- **Your right to object to processing** – You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data. [Read more about the right to object to processing.](#)
- **Your right to data portability** – You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal information you gave us to another organisation, or to you. [Read more about the right to data portability.](#)
- **Your right to withdraw consent** – When we use consent as our lawful basis you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. [Read more about the right to withdraw consent.](#)

If you make a request, we must respond to you without undue delay and in any event within one month.

Our lawful bases for the collection and use of your data

Our lawful bases for collecting or using personal information as part of **staff recruitment, administration and management** and **network administration and management** are:

- **Consent** – we have permission from you after we gave you all the relevant information. All of your data protection rights may apply, except the right to object. To be clear, you do have the right to withdraw your consent at any time.
- **Legitimate interests** – we’re collecting or using your information because it benefits you, our organisation or someone else, without causing an undue risk of harm to anyone. All of your data protection rights may apply, except the right to portability. Our legitimate interests are:

Where we get personal information from

We collect your information from the following places:

- Send us an email
- Contact us with questions or complaints

Automatically collected when you visit our website:

- From your browser (browser type, device information)
- From your network connection (IP address)
- From your interactions with our site (pages visited, request timestamps)

How long we keep information

We retain your information for 5 years from the date when it is first received.

Who we share information with

In some circumstances, we may share information with the following organisations:

- Suppliers and service providers, for example when we collaborate to convene events or circulate information that is aligned with the GETN's mission and values.

How to complain

If you have any concerns about our use of your personal data, you can make a complaint to us using the contact details at the top of this privacy notice.

If you remain unhappy with how we've used your data after raising a complaint with us, you can also complain to the ICO.
